Population register

The population register is a database which includes the primary personal data of the people who are the data subjects of the population register. The population register data are used for fulfilling the duties assigned to the state, local municipalities, and legal or natural persons. These duties are fulfilled based on the primary data registered in the population register.

The register is managed and developed by the Ministry of the Interior as the data controller and the IT and Development Centre of the Ministry of the Interior as the data processor.
